Business Program

- ◆ A three-month German Language Course beginning January is required of all Business students.
- ◆ Depending on your level of German at the end of the language program, before the semester you may choose to enroll in business courses in either English or German.
- ◆ A variety of business courses in English: Strategic Marketing Management, Economic Policy in Germany, and Quality Management in Europe. Courses designed for all business students rather than just for Americans.

English & Computer Science Programs

- ◆ Courses in American and British Literature are available to English majors and are taught in English.
- ◆ Also available are courses in Applied Computer Science. Paderborn concentrates on **computer science** and its application, and especially on **IT-related** aspects of interdisciplinary collaboration involving all the academic departments of the university.
