Requirements

- ◆ Business Major
- ◆ Students should generally have completed their junior year
- ◆ Overall GPA of 2.5 or higher

The Business Program

- ◆ Participants will study the cultural environment of business
- ◆ Opportunity to learn about specific areas of Japanese business: Marketing in Japan, Management in Innovative Japanese Firms, and Money and Banking in Japan
- ◆ Visits to Japanese firms and cultural sites are an integral part of the program

Academic Credit

- ◆ Six hours of credit for two classes
- ◆ INB 245: Business Studies Abroad (Major Elective)
- ◆ IDS 133 (any Humanities or Social Sciences section in the Outer Core).

Cost

- ◆ The budget estimate includes ISU tuition, insurance, OISP Fees, International Student ID Card, program support fees, airfare, passport, housing, all meals, personal expenses, local transportation, company visits and cultural field trips
