

## NON-ISU Study Abroad Students Admission Information

If you would like to receive Illinois State University academic credit for your participation in Study Abroad, you must be admitted to our University.

### UNDERGRADUATE Application Information

- 1) **Application may be found on the web site <http://www.admissions.ilstu.edu/apply/download.shtml>** or on request, an application can be mailed to your home address
- 2) *If you are a college student who has completed less than 30 hours of college credit you will have to submit BOTH your high school and college transcripts. If you have more than 30 hours of college credit, you need a Statement of Good Standing, which you can obtain from the Registrar at your current institution. (If you have attended more than one college or university submit **all** transcripts)*
- 3) Print out pages 5, 6 & 7 (A1-3) of the **Undergraduate Admission/Readmission Application** - (Do not submit on line)
- 4) Complete all sections taking notice of information provided below
  - # 3: Check summer only (fill in year) or fall/spring (fill in year) and write in “only”
  - # 5: Check Unclassified
  - #19: Write Unclassified (leave code number and minor information blank)
  - # 24 & 25: Leave blank
  - #28 & 29: Application fee is waived for Study Abroad Students so leave blank
  - #30-34: Leave blank

### GRADUATE Application Information

- 1) **Application may be found on the web site <http://www.admissions.ilstu.edu/apply/download.shtml>** or on request, an application will be mailed to your home address
- 2) Print out the **Graduate Admission/Readmission Application** (Do not submit on line) *No Transcripts are required, as you should apply as a Student-at-Large*
- 3) Print out pages 3 and 4
- 4) Complete all sections taking notice of information provided below
  - Section 3: Check term that you are applying for (fill in year and write in “only”)
  - Section 4: Check Non-Degree seeking
  - Section 15: Check NO
  - Section 18: Write in - 8900 Student-at-large
  - Section 19: Be sure to indicate where and when you received an Undergraduate Degree
  - Section 20: Leave Blank
  - Section 22: Sign & Date
  - Section 23: Sign & Date
  - Section 24: Application fee is waived for Study Abroad Students so leave blank

**Financial Aid Note:** Only students seeking a degree from Illinois State University are eligible to apply for Financial Aid from Illinois State. Other students must make arrangements with their home institutions.
