### Tuscania

- ◆ Located on the borders of the Tuscany and Lazio regions of central Italy close to Rome and just south of Florence
- ◆ Known throughout history for its picturesque setting, dreamy landscapes, medieval walls, cobbled streets and fine foods

### Lorenzo De'Medici

- ◆ Facility is located in the old town centre, physically incorporated into the medieval stone walls
- ◆ Students will have access to a computer lab, library, beautiful courtyard, and a fully equipped teaching kitchen

- ◆ Open to all majors, with many General Education courses
- ◆ Study for 4 or 8 weeks earning 6 to 12 hours of credits

- ◆ ISU Cum GPA of 2.5
- ◆ 2 semesters at ISU or other university
