Taipei:

- Situated between the Danshui and Xindian rivers at the northern tip of the country
- Home to Taipei 101—the world's tallest completed skyscraper
- Scenic spots include: Zhi-nan Temple, Mao-kong Tourist Tea Garden, and National Chiang Kai-shek Memorial Hall
- One of the world's most densely populated urban areas

National Chengchi University (NCCU):

- Public university
- Located at the foot of the Zhi-nan Mountain, 15 minutes south of Taipei, with Jing-mei river to the west
- The university's Chinese Language Center has been providing Mandarin Chinese language education for over 30 years

Academic Programs:

- Open to all majors
- General education courses available
- Exchange semester or full year for ISU students only
- May earn 15 credits per semester
- Intensive Chinese (Mandarin) language courses available

Spring: first Monday in October

- Overall GPA of 2.5 or higher

4. Make an appointment with the Financial Aid Office—if you qualify
5. Complete and turn in application along with required paperwork to Fell Hall Room 308 **before** the application deadline
